

Escalating medical and car repair costs contribute to insurance cancellations

FRANKFORT—Escalating medical and car repair costs are contributing to widespread cancellations of auto insurance policies, according to Kentucky Insurance Commissioner Harold McGuffey.

Nationwide, an average hospital stay in 1965 cost \$11, the figure skyrocketed to \$1,837 in 1975, McGuffey said.

Moreover, the commission stated that the cost of auto parts has risen some 80 per cent in the past four years. Labor costs are also undergoing similar increases, he said.

McGuffey said the amount of surplus underwriters are required to maintain is also contributing to increased policy cancellations, a factor he said largely due to the layman.

EKU to install permanent during Founders celebration

Senators tell delegation to expect new farm bill

BIRMINGHAM—Dr. J.C. Powell will be installed as Eastern Kentucky University's seventh president during a two-day celebration March 23-24 that will include observance of Eastern's 71st Founders Day.

Dr. Powell will be installed at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday, March 23. The program will be presided over by a procession of delegates and the University's regents, faculty and staff of 10-15 men.

The main event of Founders Day, which commemorates the anniversary of the establishment of Eastern Kentucky State Normal School in 1906 by the State Legislature, will be a 6:30 p.m. dinner Tuesday, March 22, in the Grand Ballroom of the Keen Johnson Building.

FDA plans to require Yellow No. 5 be listed

FRANKFORT—The federal Food and Drug Administration (FDA) plans to require that a widely used color additive be listed by name when used as an ingredient in foods.

Yellow No. 5, now identified only as "artificial," is used in beverages, candy, snacks, cereal, bakery goods, cereals and chocolate, dairy products and dressings.

The FDA is also considering banning the color from certain categories of drugs, both non-prescription and prescription products.
