### Guidelines approved, Act to be implemented

Frankfort — The Advisory Committee for Educational Improvement yesterday recommended guidelines for local districts to implement the Educational Improvement Act, passed by the 1976 General Assembly.

The guidelines will now be considered by the State Board for Elementary and Secondary Education at its quarterly meeting Sept. 14. When the guidelines are approved by the board, they will be sent to local school districts to aid them in developing their educational improvement plans.

House Bill 579 calls for a statewide committee to study and recommend a program and develop a local improvement plan to address the educational weaknesses.

Each district will use test results from prior years and information gathered during public hearings at each school to determine the strengths and weaknesses of the local district. Depending on the resources available, districts will not necessarily address all areas of weakness. The educational improvement plan, according to Randy Kinniburgh, head of the Bureau of Instruction.

Dr. Donald Van Fleet, head of the Office of Research and Planning, said that the guidelines would be primarily subject in many districts in all other subject areas.

### Price supports available for loose leaf method

Burley tobacco grade standards and price support regulations were changed Aug. 10 to make grading and price support available for a limited amount of 1978 crop burley that will be sold in unbleached burley as a crop marketing experiment.

Previously, unbleached burley was classified "No. 1" (No-Grade) and was ineligible for government price support.

Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland said that the changes are substantially as proposed July 6, and that the grade loss and grade standards for unbleached burley tobacco will be the same as for tied bundles. This is in line with most of the comments received in response to the proposal, Bergland said.

Under the changes, producers interested in marketing unbleached burley this year may apply in September at their county Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) office. These producers must certify that they intend to open a representative bale in each lot opened for inspection by a department member.

Other details concerning price support for unbleached burley tobacco will be published soon in the Federal Register and will be available at appropriate ASCS County Offices.
