The Laffer Curve, an interesting idea

The Laffer Curve is an interesting idea which Dr. Arthur B. Laffer has had increasing opportunity to expound upon since the State of California recently passed Proposition 13, the Jarvis Amendment, to roll back property taxes.

Laffer was Chief Economist of President Richard Nixon's Office of Management and the Budget, and his curve is his graphic exposition of his theory that, after a certain point, increases in tax rates will actually produce decreases in tax revenues. The reason: beyond that optimum point the productivity of tax-sated society will decrease along with consumer spending and business investment.
