Kay's Kitchen

If you have been keeping an eye on the forecast for beef, you know the picture looks pretty gloomy. You may feel you have served ground beef in every pot, pan, and bowl. But the recipe this week will be a little different. First, I will suggest you buy ground chuck or ground round. It may sound a little more like you get more meat per pound. Why pay \$1.09 or more for fat to try away. Besides tasting better, it is better for you.

- 1 1/2 pounds ground chuck or round
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped green pepper
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 2 tablespoons chopped parsley
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon Tabasco sauce
- 1/2 teaspoon thyme
- Combine the meat, Tabasco sauce and thyme. Shape into eight oval patties. Broil about six minutes on each side or to desired degree of doneness. Arrange on a serving platter and pour bearnaise sauce over steaks.
