IRS sets date for examination

Louisville — The deadline for filing an application to take the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Special Enrollment Examination is August 15, 1978, the IRS has announced. The examination, to be given on September 25 and 26, 1978, is given annually to qualify persons who are neither CPAs nor attorneys to represent clients before the IRS.

Persons who want to take the examination must submit Form 2567, Application for the 1978 Special Enrollment Examination, to the Director, Audit Division, Internal Revenue Service, Washington, D. C. 20224. No extensions of time to file applications will be granted beyond August 15, 1978, the IRS said.

The application must be accompanied by a recent photo of the applicant, which will be used for identification purposes only, and a check or money order for the examination fee, made payable to the Internal Revenue Service.

No fees will be refunded to an applicant who fails to take the examination, but they may be applied as a credit toward next year's application fee. Circumstances under which credits may be authorized are provided on application Form 2567.

The 1978 examination will have an increased emphasis on Federal tax laws as they apply to business operations such as sole proprietorships, partnerships, and corporations.

Publication 486, "Requirements for Internal Revenue Service Enrollment and Special Enrollment Examination," identifies sources of tax information that may be helpful in preparing for the examination. The examination will include true or false and multiple choice questions in all of the four parts of the examination.

Application Form 2567; copies of Publication 486 and Publication 603, Sample Booklet "1977 Special Enrollment Examination Questions and Answers," are available from the IRS.
