Bath one of nine Kentucky counties for wild turkey hunting

Although most sportsmen are getting geared up for spring fishing, there's a small but dedicated group of hunters who are making last-minute preparations for their season.

April is wild turkey hunting month in Kentucky. Although turkey hunting does not rank among our major outdoor pursuits, its followers are growing in numbers as turkeys are restored to

more and more areas of the state. This year turkey hunters must purchase a "turkey permit" similar to the one issued to deer hunters. The permit, which costs \$5.00, is required of all resident and non-resident turkey hunters in addition to the appropriate annual hunting license. A three-day non-resident license is not valid for turkey hunting.

The 10-day turkey season this year opens April 21 and runs through April 30. The counties open to turkey hunting are Bath, Butler, Jackson, Lee, Letcher, Menifee, Owsley, Pike and Rowan. The Pine Mountain Wildlife Management area in Letcher County and the Pioneer Weapons area in Bath and Menifee Counties will be open during this period, but no turkey hunting will be permitted at the Breaks Interstate Park in Pike County.

There will also be turkey seasons at Land Between the Lakes, Ft. Campbell and Ft. Knox. At LBI, the season opens April 11 and runs through April 20. Ft. Campbell will allow hunting on April 21, 22, 28 and 29.

Hunts at Ft. Knox are scheduled for every Saturday and Sunday in April except April 1. Military or post civilian personnel have first priority, but off-post civilians will be permitted to hunt if space is available, providing they apply in person on the Friday before the weekend when they want to hunt. For additional information, call Ft. Knox at (502) 524-7311.

Ft. Campbell and LBI also have special requirements. For details, call (502) 798-2413 for Ft. Campbell and (502) 924-0022 for LBI.

Turkey hunting will be permitted from one-half hour before sunrise until noon, except on LBI and Ft. Campbell, where hunters may stay out until one-half hour after sunset, local prevailing time. Hand or mouth operated turkey calls are allowed but electronic calls are prohibited.
