

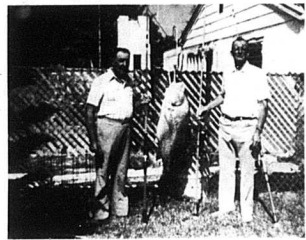

600.00 four grave lot 300.00 perpetual Care—price 900.00
1200.00 eight grave lot 500.00 perpetual Care—price 1700.00
Extra will be charged for Corner Stones.
For time payments on buying graves—Contact board members.
Opening of Graves will be Cash.
Monday through Friday—price... \$175.00
Saturday—price... 225.00*
Sunday—price... 250.00*
*Due to higher labor cost on Saturday and Sunday.
Monuments will be on display and may be bought through Caretaker. Foundations will be made by cemetery only—at following prices for 10x20 footstone \$20.00; for 24x12 stone \$30.00. All other sizes will be \$3.50 per cubic foot.
Refrilling graves and sodding will be \$25.00. Trimming of shrubbery and flowers planted on graves will be time and material. No one should sow grass seed in Cemetery without approval of Caretaker.
Money willed to Cemetery will be used as follows unless specified differently—50% put perpetual Care savings account, 50% in general use.
