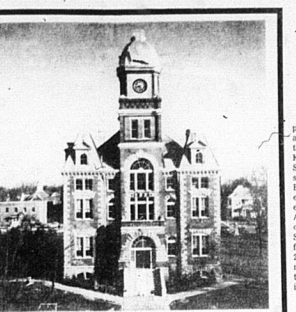

Policies of land sales.

Sales of land tobacco are year-around, and not seasonal. Acting under restrictions set up in each year's land agreement by the Community Credit Corporation the barley crop is required to be ready to supply purchasers any time of year.

With large supply and domestic firms, as well as manufacturers and jobbed dealers, constantly "shopping" the wares of the barley association, many transactions occur at near market time. Some farmers have marked objections to this inasmuch that they are not allowed to sell their own crop. The Association has explained in reply that it is required to sell tobacco at the lowest possible price and cannot suddenly and unpredictably, and the crop with many millions of pounds of grown-out tobacco on hand, all of it under loan by Federally advanced funds, must be sold by the lender's order. Acting as banker overseeing sales procedures, prices are set, hence, the CCC also keeps watch on the pace of transactions. If it feels that land stocks are not moving fast enough, it calls upon the coop to speed up its marketing operations.

Burley stocks selling from co-op's pool

Apparently spurred by reports of a short crop of 1979 burley tobacco, the sales of storage stocks of leaf held under loan have taken a sharp increase recent weeks.

The largest sale involves \$5,879,906 pounds, one of the largest single transactions in several years by the Burley Tobacco Growers Cooperative Association. It was announced this week at the monthly meeting of the Association's board of directors, by Alvin H. Beckley, executive secretary-treasurer.

A total of 6,220 burling bags were purchased in all, at average grades from the 1975 and 1977 loan contracts.

Under loan agreements rules of the Community Credit Corporation, which supplies funds to support the crop, co-op administrators the price support program, a selling service is maintained at all times through the Lexington office of the Association.

The lending agency prescribes all rules and procedures under which the selling program operates. Otherwise, funds to support the crop are not available. The Washington-based CCC dictates grade prices on sales, sale
