## Kay's Kitchen

**PARTY FOODS:**  
**ARTICHOKE DIP**  
1 can artichokes, drained (1 cup)  
1 cup mayonnaise  
1 cup Parmesan cheese  
Mix well and take in small casserole until well set. Use as a spread for whole wheat crackers.

**SPINACH DIP**  
1 package frozen chopped spinach, thaw and squeeze out all liquid  
1 cup chopped parsley  
1 teaspoon pepper  
2 tablespoons dried onion  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 cup mayonnaise  
Combine all ingredients and refrigerate overnight.

**SHRIMP BUTTER**  
2 cans shrimp (4 1/2 or 5 1/2 oz.)  
1 tablespoon minced onion  
Juice of 1 lemon  
3 tablespoons mayonnaise  
8 oz. package cream cheese  
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder  
Combine ingredients and blend in blender. Add a little salt and pepper.

**HAM PUFFS**  
2 tama deuced ham, 4 1/2 or 5 1/2 oz. size  
2 tablespoons mayonnaise  
3 tablespoons semi-sweet white, Medeira or Tawny Port  
In small mixing bowl combine all ingredients and refrigerate.

**CHEESE PUFFS**  
1/4 cup water  
1/4 cup butter, softened  
1/2 cup flour  
2 eggs  
1/2 cup finely grated sharp cheese  
Dash of cayenne  
Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Bring water and butter to boil in a medium sauce pan (butter should be melted).

**CURRIED PECANS**  
1 pound shelled pecans  
4 tablespoons melted butter  
4 teaspoons curry powder, more or less  
Mix butter and add curry powder. Mix with pecans. Spread out on a shallow baking pan and toast in 300 degree oven for about 25 minutes or until crisp, stirring frequently. Cool and store in tin.
