

# Key's Kitchen

Here we are again wondering what to do with those bits of leftover turkey, ham or what have you. You probably feel you never want another ham or turkey again. Unless there is a really easy and tasty freezing good size portion which I would suggest making a casserole and freezing for use later. Six months from now you would have a nice meal practically ready just by thawing.

Try this if you have only a small portion of meat. Cook 1 cup of macaroni according to package directions. Make 1/2 cups rich, well seasoned cheese sauce. In 2 tablespoons of margarine cook about 1/2 green pepper and one medium onion until limp. Add 1 can of mushroom pieces and one chicken bouillon cube. Combine 1 cup or more of turkey with drained macaroni and onion. Add 1/2 cup of cheese sauce and one egg. Sprinkle with paprika and heat until bubbly in a 300 degree oven.

You may want to try this once while hot. What is left get cold in dish, then remove with spatula to freezing paper. Wrap securely and label. If you want to freeze all, let pan in and then turn on or freezer paper and cut into amount needed for your family or leave whole.
