The meeting, which is open to the general public, will begin at 10 a.m. at Memorial Hall (located on South Lexington Street) on the campus of the University of Kentucky in Lexington.

Farm facts contained in study

WASHINGTON - Farm residents are less likely to do out of work than their nonfarm counterparts, but they are more likely to be older and to earn less. These are among the highlights of a description of the U. S. farm population published today by the Bureau of the Census and the U. S. Department of Agriculture's Economics, Statistics, and Cooperatives Service (ESCS). The 1977 farm population, at just over 17 million, continued to decline while small town and open county nonfarm population showed renewed growth.
