This week I am simply going to give you several recipes using hamburger, or ground meat, whichever you use. If you do use hamburger, remember to drain off the fat that will accumulate when frying, before adding to the rest of the ingredients in the recipe, if this is possible.

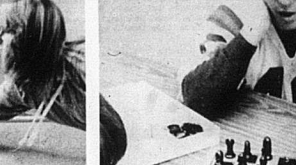
