Carlisle's new telephone directory has now been mailed, according to M. I. Seibert, local South Central Bell manager. Telephone service started in Kentucky 100 years ago, and the oldest directory was printed just a year later, in 1880. It's quite a contrast to the new Carlisle phone book since it only had 75 pages, listing some 600 numbers, he said. The telephone numbers were included because people didn't call numbers then, he said. They simply called Central, asked for the party they wanted by name and the operator connected them. Instructions in the front of the directory explained how to use the book. In the days of the long line, it was necessary to have a separate book for each party. Black, five-foot-tall Isaac Burns Murphy was 44 percent of all the horse races he rode in a record that has not been broken by any American jockey and he was a Kentuckian. He is recognized primarily for his Kentucky Derby record, winning three in all, which was not equaled until 1930 by Earle Sande and not surpassed until 1948 by Eddie Arcaro when he won his fourth Derby on Citation.

Murphy won the 1881 Derby on Ruby and the 1884 Derby on Kingston. He was a "walking Derby" in an uncanny sense of pace, had a serene personality and was never in a hurry. He could have made enough to buy a Bluegrass farm if he wanted. He was a great horse trainer, having trained 14 Kentucky Derby winners and 18 Belmont Stakes winners.

His funeral was the biggest in Lexington's history up to that time, with 500 people, black and white, in attendance. He was buried in a Lexington cemetery which through the years became neglected, so that his grave was lost for decades. Recently Murphy's remains were moved to the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington and placed next to those of Man o' War.
