Mt. Olivet gets convention center
 FRANKFORT—Gov. Julian Carroll has announced the awarding of a \$40,000 grant to go toward construction of a community and convention center at Mount Olivet, the county seat of Robertson County.
 The grant to the Robertson County Fiscal Court, which is developing the center, was approved today by the advisory board of the state's local convention and community centers fund administered by the Development Cabinet.

Development Secretary William in Short noted that Mount Olivet is near Blue Licks Battlefield State Park and said the convention center will be utilized as a starting-point for tours of the park and Robertson County.
 The state grant will go toward the estimated \$100,000 cost of the center, he said. The center will be adjacent to the new fire hall and public library, at the intersection of Main and Wal-

nut streets. It will provide space for a senior citizens program, large group meetings and continuing education classes.
