PARTY FOODS:
HOLIDAY HAM BALLS
1 pound ground ham and 1/2 pound ground pork, mixed
1/2 cup soft bread crumbs
1 egg
1/4 cup grated onion
2 tablespoons milk
Seasoned salt to taste
Combine ingredients and shape into small balls. Place on cookie sheet and bake 50 degrees for 20 to 25 minutes. Place balls in chafing dish and cover with Sweet-Sour Sauce.

SWEET-SOUR SAUCE
1 cup brown sugar
1/4 cup vinegar
4 teaspoons cornstarch
2 teaspoons dry mustard
Cook together until thick. Taste for seasoning. You may add pineapple chunks and green pepper strips if desired.

HOT CRAB APPETIZERS
1 1/2 cups (one 1/2 can) Alaska King crab, drained and sliced
1/4 cup mayonnaise
2 tablespoons chili sauce
1/4 teaspoon lemon juice
2 tablespoons chopped pimiento stuffed olives
1 tablespoon finely minced celery
Salt and pepper
1 (8 ounce) package refrigerated (creamer) rice
Combine all ingredients except rice. Taste for seasoning. Unroll rice and separate into 4 rectangles. Spread crab filling on each rectangle and roll from longwise side. Cut each roll into 8 pieces. Place cut side down on lightly greased baking sheet. Bake at 375

2-ounce package cream cheese
1/2 pound Blue cheese
1/2 pound extra sharp cheddar cheese, grated
2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
1/4 teaspoon cayenne
1/4 teaspoon seasoned salt
2 tablespoons grated onion
1 clove garlic, grated
1 cup chopped pecans
Combine cheeses in mixer bowl and beat until well blended. Add Worcestershire sauce, cayenne, seasoned salt, onion, garlic and 1/2 cup of the chopped pecans. Shape into a ball and roll in remaining pecans. Chill thoroughly. Serve with assorted crackers and fresh fruit. Makes 12 balls.
