Mr. Rose called Friday and regretfully declined the honor. General Sherman you may remember was the fellow who said "If nominated I will not campaign, if elected I will not serve."

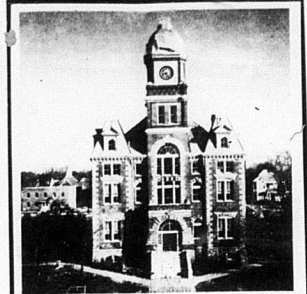
