With the changing of seasons, (and by this time I must give up summer and accept Fall), appetites seem to change and there is a more general interest in food. So in these rainy days, lets branch out and serve something different. To face facts we are stuck with the same cuts of beef, pork, lamb, veal and fish, but you can change their flavor by using sauces, herbs, spices and seasonings. Don't be afraid to try new combinations. When you get into an experimental mood, invite a couple in to share in the excitement. If the dinner is a "flap" you can always fix scrambled eggs and bacon! There are things you can do to scrambled eggs too, that will make them a good supper dish. If you have never tried curly, the following recipe is a good one to start with. Mainly because it is an inexpensive dish, easy to prepare and all you need is lost, you would still have the rice.

**TUNA - RICE CURRY**  
 3 tablespoons butter  
 1/4 cup flour  
 1/4 teaspoon curry powder (more or less)  
 2 cups milk  
 1 cup grated cheddar cheese  
 1/2 cup (1 1/2 ounce can) tuna  
 3 tablespoons chopped parsley or parsnip  
 2 1/2 cups cooked rice (approximately)  
 In saucepan, melt butter. Blend in flour and curry powder, gradually add milk, boil one bubble and cook over medium heat stirring constantly until mixture thickens. Add cheese and tuna, cooking until cheese is melted. Spoon the rice around the edge of warm serving platter; fill center with hot tuna mixture. Top with freshly ground black pepper.

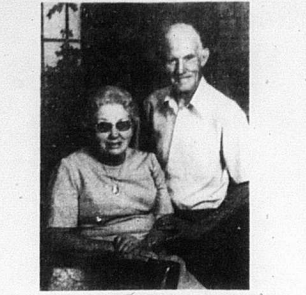
