### Producer eligibility requirements

Applications are now being taken for new farm burley tobacco quotas. Interested producers should file application at the local Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service (ASCS) office by Feb. 15. Listed below are the requirements for obtaining a new farm quota.

Neither the owner nor operator shall own, have any ownership interest in, or operate another farm in the United States for which a tobacco quota for any kind of tobacco is established for the current year.

Producers may not request establishment of a quota for more than one farm.

The operator must own, or have readily available, equipment and other facilities necessary for the production of burley tobacco.

### Use of nitrogen saves energy

Kentucky farmers should be aware that nitrogen fertilizer represents one of the largest energy inputs in corn production.

Now, there is research indicating that better management of nitrogen fertilizer in no-tillage operations will reduce the farmer's use of energy and his production costs.

More efficient use of nitrogen fertilizer in corn production will help reduce energy requirements up to seven percent when using no-tillage, compared with conventional tillage methods, according to studies made by the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture.

### Dec. 16 Burley quota hearing

Remember Tuesday, Dec. 16, at 10 a.m. in the Nicholas County ASC building for a public hearing in the U.S. Good Barn at the U. of Ky. College of Agriculture.

An indication that the USDA is considering increases of from 1% to 7% percent in the burley tobacco quota for the past two short crop years have led to a tight world market for burley.

"At present, total stocks plus estimated 1980 production are 56 million pounds below the reserve supply level," said the USDA summary.

The 1% percent increase over 1980 quota would allow for 630 million pounds, while the 7% percent increase would put the national quota at 660 million, or 5 percent above projected 1980 use.

First word of any pool commitments on the present market was a listing of 2,650 pounds, taken under loan during the first week of the 1980-81 auction. Most markets have reported no pooled tobacco so far. Last year at this time 71,766 pounds had been taken, according to H. Beckley, executive treasurer of the Association.

All burley loan stocks from previous years have been sold.

World use of burley has been rising with increased cigarette consumption, especially in low tar and low nicotine types. The USDA estimates exports of U.S. burley for the 1980 crop will reach 135 million pounds, up 5 million from the year earlier.

Following the trend of recent years U.S. burley exports are projected to reach 145 million pounds for the 1981 crop.

A great way to utilize your extra funds, coupons and/or qualifiers is to organize a "round robin." Refunding readily lends itself to this "pass-along" exchange and you can enlist parties, friends or relatives clear across the country. In fact, trading with out-of-staters gives you exciting new deals to work with, a chance to keep in touch or make new friends, and chop off dollars from your grocery bill.

Q How would I start a round robin?  
A. A minimum of four people send in specified amounts of funds, cashed-in and/or proofs of purchase and request lists to the organizer (No. 1) who then assigns each person a number and marks it on their materials. No. 1 mails the pack to No. 2 who selects items from the "kit" and replaces them with the same amount of extras. No. 2 mails the robin to No. 3 and so on. That way each person has a chance to select and replace items. When the robin returns to you, unwanted materials with your number are pulled out so that there's always a new batch to choose from.
