Choose children's gifts with safety

When shopping for children's holiday gifts, beware of those that pose threats to eyes, cautions the Kentucky Society to Prevent Blindness.

Nationwide more than 5,000 eye injuries were linked to toys last year and nearly two-thirds of these accidents were suffered by children under the age of 15. BB guns, darts and bows and arrows were responsible for another 1,100 eye injuries among youngsters in this age range.

"Ninety percent of all eye injuries are preventable," noted Elinor Zollinger, the Society's executive director. "Safety-conscious adults can protect children from eye damage — and in some cases the loss of an eye — by picking toys and games carefully and by teaching youngsters how to play safely."

Children how to use their toys properly. Does the child understand how to use the toy? Does the child take a "harmless" toy and make it dangerous, for example, by pulling rubber tips off darts? Do older children keep their more complicated toys out of reach of younger brothers and sisters? When dangers are explained, does the child acknowledge and avoid them?

"Remember these playful tips and safeguard your child's sight — during the holidays and through the year," Zollinger concluded.

The Kentucky Society to Prevent Blindness is the only voluntary health agency in Kentucky engaged solely in preventing blindness, through community service programs, public and professional education.

Holiday gifts hopefully will bring children many hours of enjoyment and help to expand their knowledge all year long, without jeopardizing their well-being," Ms. Zollinger added. "Play things with projectiles have been proven dangerous to eyes and should be avoided.

Eye damage also can result from toys and games with less apparent hazards. Building sets, skateboards and battery-
