For each additional member over eight, add \$2 per month.

Also effective Jan. 1, deductions used to calculate net income for food stamp households will be updated to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index. The standard deduction will increase from \$75 to \$85. In addition, the maximum deduction a family may claim for excess shelter costs and dependent care will rise from a combined total \$90 to \$115. The maximum deduction for shelter and dependent care costs has not been adjusted for 18 months. The increase announced recently reflects increases over this one and a half year period in the cost of shelter, fuel and utilities.

Tables with the new allotments and benefit levels appeared in the Dec. 2 Federal Register.

currently earn less than \$3.35 an hour. Nationally, more than 5.6 million of the 60 million workers covered by the act will be eligible for pay increases.

The Jan. 1 change in the minimum wage was provided for in 1977 amendments to the act.

MacDonald said most of the Kentucky workers receiving increases are the white-collar workers employed in service-producing industries and that about 60 percent are women.

Also beginning Jan. 1, farm workers hired by an employer who used more than 500 man-days of agricultural labor in any calendar quarter of the preceding calendar year must also be paid at least \$3.35 an hour.

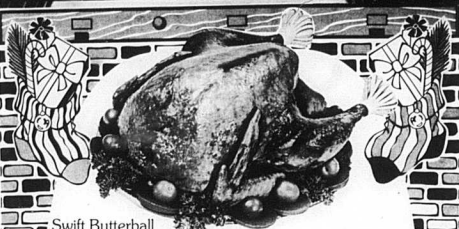
