

### State's jobless rate higher than national

Kentucky's unemployment rate rose from 8.4 percent in November to 8.5 percent in December, according to statistics released last week by the Department of Human Resources. The December rate is 1.3 percent higher than the 7.2 percent national unemployment rate for the month.

Developed Kentucky counties numbered 10,400 in December, 8,400 more than during November, said Robert MacDonald, labor market analyst for the department.

"The December increase was due to seasonal hiring in the construction, trade and service industries and a general slowdown in the state's economy which brought about layoffs in the mining, retailing and real estate industries," MacDonald explained.

There were 1,811,860 Kentuckians employed during December, about 11,000 less than in November. Kentucky's total labor force showed little growth during 1979, increasing by 8.5 percent and averaging 1,864,900 persons. The total for the 10 percent national unemployment rate figure for 1979 figures.

"This slowdown in Kentucky's economy is reflected in the number of persons looking but unable to find work," MacDonald said. On a monthly average for 1979, there were 81,130 jobless persons in Kentucky, up 8,130 from 1978.
