Maxey Flats pact inked

A \$100,000 personal service contract for "emergency services" at the Maxey Flats nuclear waste site was approved, along with 48 other contracts, by the Personal Service Contract Review Subcommittee of the Legislative Research Committee at its June meeting last Tuesday.

The contract with Dames and Moore of White Plains, N.Y., was negotiated, representatives of the Department for Natural Resources and the Environmental Protection told the subcommittee, by the unusually large amount of rainfall received in Fleming County last year.

The rainfall threatened to flood slow-ground surface ponds holding 1.5 million gallons of radioactive water. Emergency work by Dames and Moore to divert the rainfall included the installation of a series of drains and repairs to existing pond dams.

Maxey Flats is a fast-rising ridge located 10 miles northeast of Maysfield. It is one of the low-level nuclear waste sites commercially operated in the United States.

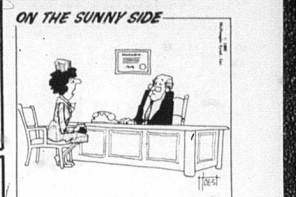

outer hills were permitted, are the solution. The choice of heavy, flexible plastic pots and sizes and provide extra exchange for good root growth. Specific types, porous walls. Plastic pots are inexpensive and lightweight, which makes them easy to move around. There is no evaporation through the container sides so water is conserved more efficiently. Putting more water in light and mossy, to allow air circulation to the roots. Choose the heavy, flexible plastic pots for best durability and pick white or light colors as dark pots absorb too much heat from the sun and can damage plants.

WOOD containers are among the most attractive available and with this material, shapes and sizes are almost endless. Pick reddish,ypress or cedar for specific types, wood, however, as these woods rot decay and rot faster. For the life of wood containers, treat them with a copper naphthenate or other preservative. Water using a clear-drying water sealant, which will seal more than four seasons.
