However, I was shocked to see the statement in the article by Mr. Conley and the editorial that they had not been accomplished within the last 31 years. Either your mathematics or your history needs to be replaced. A quick perusal of my dusty year book, the Nicholas Gazette - 1949, turned up the enclosed action picture of a Nicholas County High School and Harrison County game with the caption reading "Nicholas County 48 - Harrison County 44." The Nicholas County players identified in the photograph are Honey Leitcher, Red Jennings and myself. Other starting members of the team were Billy Mathes and Donnie Hillcock.

Other members of the team were Buddy Taylor and Jimmy Dowling and the coach was Charles Fryer. I am sure that we lost Harrison County at least one other time during that season, in the regional tournament and perhaps also in our other meetings to detract from the excellent accomplishment of my fellow team. I did want to call your attention to this oversight. The season of 1950-51 is still vivid in my mind, especially the game with Harrison County mentioned above. I can recall being carried off the floor over the game by our fans but by my beloved principal Willard Skidmore. That memory still remains vivid even after the passage of 34 years.
