## Is blue mold coming here?

To keep blue mold out of tobacco beds, you need to maintain complete coverage of the foliage with the fungicide from the time plants are dime-size until resetting is completed, according to Neuzil. This means spraying after every rain and often enough to protect new foliage of the rapidly growing tobacco plants.

## Gas prices up again

The average cost of gasoline in central and eastern Kentucky increased three cents per gallon in April at full-service stations and four cents at self-service pumps, according to the Blue Grass Automobile Club's monthly Fuel Gauge report.  
As of April 18, the average cost of gasoline for full-service pumps is \$1.22 for regular; \$1.30 for premium; \$1.27 for no-lead and \$1.18 for diesel. Self-service averages are \$1.16 for regular;

## Cities must

The council or board may amend the budget. The legislative body then passes the amended budget as a budget ordinance.  
As soon as possible after the close of the fiscal year, a city must audit each of its accounts. It must complete the audit no later than 270 days after the close of the fiscal year. It can contract with a certified public accountant for this audit. Once the audit is complete, the accountant is to forward a copy of the audit, along with a report, to the Auditor of Public Accounts. The city must send two copies of the audit and report to the Department for Local Government.
