Local calling rates will be four cents for the first minute of each call and two cents for each additional minute. As with long distance calls, substantial discounts apply for off-hour calling.

Local calling charges are reduced 25 percent for calls made between 5 p.m. and 11 p.m., Sunday through Friday. Charges are reduced 60 percent for calls made between 11 p.m. and 8 a.m. weekdays, all day Saturday, and before 5 p.m. on Sunday.

In larger cities, distance would also be a factor.

"In the future," said Starnes, "this alternative rate will become even more important as inflation and increased calling push up the cost of providing home telephone service."

According to the Commission's order, measured service "more equitably distributes the cost of telephone service."

Starnes said the measured service option allows people who seldom use the phone to pay less when using their phone less.

"This makes the service attractive to many customers who are willing to reduce their calling to save money," he said.

Starnes said Bell is currently moving to get its equipment ready in Frankfurt.
