Educational sales tax is suspended Gov. Brown after he was advised by his general counsel, the Department of Revenue and the attorney general that Section 179 of the Kentucky Constitution exempts educational and charitable institutions from all state taxes.

Volume increased slightly from \$15.5 million last year to \$16.6 million. Swann told the session that "volume through the co-op's 87 owned branches totaled \$11.6 million, an increase of 20 percent. Net savings after taxes came to \$4 million, a 31 percent increase over the previous year."

Managed local farm supply and petroleum cooperatives ended their fiscal year on Dec. 31, 1979. They had combined volume of \$22.7 million after taxes compared with \$14 million last year. Net savings were \$6.1 million after taxes as compared to \$3.5 million last year.

Private agencies and independent local farm supply cooperatives had wholesale purchases of \$108.8 million, up from \$115 million last year. In reporting on the co-op's grain marketing operation, Mullins said that "despite some adverse marketing factors, including depressed prices and the Russian grain embargo, two records were reached a new high at \$93.9 million, and net savings had exceeded previous records at \$1.1 million before taxes. Armstrong told the session that although all commodity groups contributed to the year's dollar volume increase, more than half, \$68.8 million out of the \$117.4 million gain, resulted from petroleum price increase and net savings in this division. 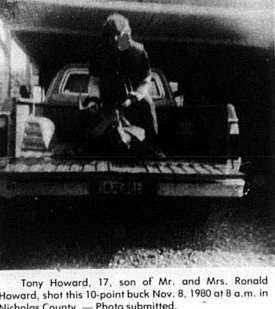
