### Festivals set at Renfro Valley and Springfield

Two of the most interesting festivals in Kentucky are set for the weekend of Oct. 10-12. The Renfro Valley "Lanes Meets" and the Springfield "Lanes Meets" are scheduled in Springfield.

At both the Renfro Valley gathering and the Springfield cookoff, sorghum molasses is made the old-time way. When they raise cane, the people in the Rockcastle and Washington counties really raise it.

The cane stalks are cut in the field, stripped of dead heads and transported to the cane mill site. Here a mule or horse goes around and around in a seemingly endless circle, providing the power to operate a mill that squeezes sweet juice from each cane stalk. The juice is funneled through a pipe, sometimes a handmade wooden trough, to the evaporator pans.

The "pan" is a tabular metal piece of equipment designed with a series of compartments. When the cane juice is in the first compartments it usually is green. As it cooks it is pushed along into the divisions until it is amber-gold and tastes like nectar.

In days gone by, the foam that remained in the pans was what the countryside had turned out for. With a piece of cane stalk in hand, each visitor dipped into the warm, sweet foam to taste again the tang of molasses made the country way, the natural way.

The Springfield event also features country band sandwiches, fried sausage, popcorn, candy, fresh cider, cakes and pies.

At Renfro Valley October is Country Music Month and any event in this famous section of the commonwealth includes music. It was at Renfro Valley that stars such as Red Foley, Homer and Jethro, Lily May and the Coon Creek Girls, Old Joe Clark, Merle Travis and scores of others started on musical careers.

Each day of the molasses making at Renfro Valley will include turkey shoots, horseback pitching, arts and crafts, specialties, concessions and cider making. While they're making molasses "on the grounds," they also ask everyone to bring along a gular, cany or fiddle for country music jam on the spot.

The Renfro Valley Festival starts at 1 p.m. Oct. 10 and continues that day till 6 p.m. A special show in the big Renfro Valley Barn is set for 8 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Shows are set for the festival daily, with a country music talent hall all day and special shows at 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Renfro Valley is "the valley where time stands still" and is located on I-75 at the Mt. Vernon exit.

You rub out this "instant form" at the checkout on your next shopping trip and receive V.I.C. (Value In Cash) or refund right there! Drop me a line if you've discovered any of these on your own. It is an excellent innovation and lets more manufacturers pick up on the idea.

Q. What if there's a special sale and due to demand the store has run out of the product?  
A. Most supermarkets will either offer you a comparable item at the sale price or issue a raincheck. Just ask the manager. These are usually good for 30-60 days and allow you to purchase a specified number of items at the sale price. Use them promptly.
