Kay's Kitchen

I recently had a request, wanting to know if any of our readers had a "good recipe" for never fail pie meringue. Sorry I could not answer right away, but you probably know I try to stay as far ahead with this column. So now if anyone does have a never fail pie meringue, please send it to Kay's Kitchen, in care of The Carlisle Mercury. To be honest I don't have one. In fact I don't have a "never fail" anything. There just seems to be times when things don't go right. Then there is always the weather I can blame, the phone rang at the wrong time, or something.

FOOLPROOF MERINGUE
Mix one tablespoon cornstarch and two tablespoons water with one-half cup water and cook together until clear. Then set aside. Take a bit of the egg whites, the slow addition of the sugar and the slow in which it is baked. Beat the egg whites, cream of tartar and water in the small bowl of the mixer at high speed for three minutes. Add sugar again until mixture is stiff. Pie on pie and bake for 30 minutes at 325 degrees or until golden brown.

Here is a simple Meringue recipe, easy to remember.
MERINGUE
2 egg whites
1 tablespoon sugar
1/4 teaspoon cream of tartar
Bring egg whites to room temperature. Beat until just frothy, then add sugar and cream of tartar slowly. Continue beating until egg whites hold a stiff sharp peak. Spread on pie.
