### Smoke detectors required

New homes are covered under federal regulations which require that they meet certain building specifications. This is the first attempt at bringing used homes under the same regulations, said Robinson.

The board, which is composed of nine members including the state fire marshal, the secretary of transportation and the director of health services, directs the state Fire Marshal's Office in enforcing building and safety regulations pertaining to mobile homes manufactured and sold in the state.

Robinson estimated that between 170 and 175 dealers would be affected by the regulation and the cost per unit could start at \$8, not counting installation, he said.

Copies of the proposed regulation were mailed to dealers and manufacturers earlier this year and met with no opposition, said Robinson. Enforcement will begin around Sept. 15, he said.

Failure to install a detector before reaching the home could result in a fine of up to \$1,000, a 60-day jail sentence or both. A dealer or manufacturer has up to 20 days to comply with the fire marshal's order before a hearing is held.

Private sales between individuals are not covered under the regulation, but fire officials encourage everyone to buy a detector and install it or have it installed.

commanded by Brig. Gen. Robert James. Its formation will affect more than half of the state's guard units.

Wellins said most of the changes will be small but in several communities units will change altogether. A medical company with an authorized strength of 111 will be the new guard unit in Campbell County. An armored cavalry unit with 153 troops will be formed in Owensboro, but that city will lose its present armor battalion headquarters to Bowling Green. Other communities gaining troops and the numbers gained are: Lexington, 134; Harrodsburg, 94; Hillsboro, 39; Richmond, 46; and Bowling Green, 23.

Wellins said the brigade will tie most state units together for training and will instill pride in accomplishing missions.

The changes in all units will take place on Nov. 1.
