Transportation employees cut back expenses in '80

The Kentucky Department of Transportation spent nearly \$1.2 million less in 1980 for in-state and out-of-state travel than in 1979.

Commercial air fare for out-of-state trips dropped from \$71,432 to \$60,964.

Many of the 12 district highway offices cut travel expenses by as much as 90 percent from 1979 to 1980.
