Two Colonels named all-Americans

Two Eastern Kentucky University students - defensive back George Floyd and offensive guard Kevin Greve - have been named first-team All-American on the 1981 Kodak honor squad. This was the second straight year Floyd, a 185-pound senior from Brooksville, Fla. had made the honor team, while Greve, a 317, 250-pound senior from Cincinnati, Ohio, was chosen for the first time after being picked second-team Associated Press All-American last year. "This is just great," said EKVU head coach Roy Kiser. "Both George and Kevin are deserving of this recognition and we're mighty proud of them." Floyd, a two-time winner of the Ohio Valley Conference's Defensive Player of the Year Award, led the league this year in pass interceptions with nine (returned 131 yards) and was among the league's top punt return men (32 returns for a 9.0 average and one TD). He also totaled 58 tackles, 23 assists, three caused fumbles, five tackles for losses. Greve is a three-time ABC-VC player and has served this year as one of two offensive linemen for EKVU's OVC champion 15-1 Colonels. The Kodak team is chosen by the American Football Coaches Association.

Center gets \$123 million IRB push

The state Industrial Revenue Bond Oversight Committee has approved bond financing totaling \$123.5 million to help build the proposed World Coal Center in downtown Lexington. The 30-story office building is expected to provide offices for coal and energy companies throughout the U.S. according to its developers. The building will cost an estimated \$136 million. Tax rules forbid industrial revenue bond issues exceeding \$10 million. Bond counsel for the developers told the committee that the law won't stand in the way, because the project will be financed by some 50 partnerships, each of which will issue about \$2.5 million worth of bonds. The coal center is expected to house more than 2,000 workers. The center's developer, Wallace Wilkinson, said a number of coal and energy companies have expressed strong interest in locating offices there.

The oversight committee also approved bonds for six other projects during a Nov. 23 meeting. They are: - a \$14 million office building in Jeffersontown, to be developed by Ferguson & Associates; - a \$600,000 medical office building in Boone County, to be developed by Dr. William Walker; - a \$600,000 retail store in Jefferson County for M Lumber Co.; - a \$200,000 office building in Jefferson County to serve as headquarters for Southern Strip Steel Inc. and a \$200,000 renovation of a Covington building for use as professional offices, by Phoenix Properties Partnership.
