### Burley tobacco outlook for 1981

On Feb. 1 Secretary of Agriculture Frank Annunzio said the 1981 marketing year for burley tobacco production has fallen short of total use for the second consecutive year, recent statistics show.

During the last two crop years, burley growers have produced and sold about 250 million pounds less burley tobacco than the industry has used, according to the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture. For the 1980 marketing year, ending on Oct. 1, total disappearance of burley tobacco was 625 million pounds while the 1980 crop is estimated at 560 million pounds.
