Harry Galbraith will be the guest speaker at the meeting Thursday night, Feb. 26, of the Headquarters Methodist Men.

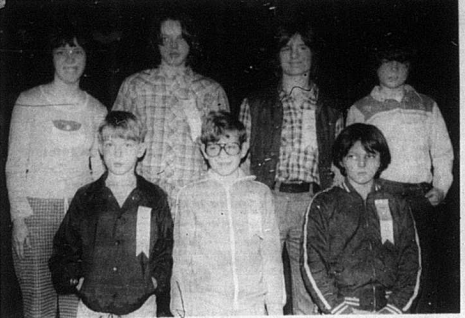
The meeting will be held at the church at 7 p.m. and all members are urged to attend.
