

Medicare insurance premium now \$11.

The monthly premium for the medical insurance part of Medicare increases to \$11 for the 15-month period starting this month. In spite of this increase, recipients are paying less than a third of the cost of this insurance. More than two-thirds are paid by the U.S. Government from general revenues, not social security taxes.

Medical insurance helps pay for doctor's services, no matter where they are received in the United States, in an office, home, hospital, or elsewhere; for out-patient hospital services; for home health care; for a person's home, and for other medical services and supplies not covered by Medicare hospital insurance.

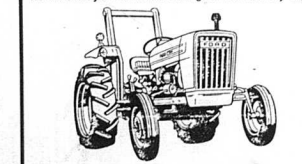

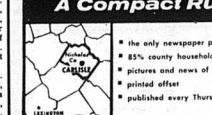
