Boats up to 18½ feet long may now operate on all state-owned lakes according to a Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources regulation change which became effective May 6.

length for boats on all but two of these lakes was 18½ feet. Lakes Malone and Bushbar, which already permitted 18½ foot boats, are unaffected by the new regulation.

The length limit for pontoon boats remains at 22 feet (except for a 30-foot limit on Malone and Bushbar). Houseboats are prohibited from these lakes and there is no length limit on canoe.

Many of these lakes were built by the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources with funds from hunting and fishing license sales. Hence, they are managed primarily as fishing lakes, with horsepower and boat size restrictions designed to favor fishermen.

The change from 16½ to 18½ maximum boat length was made because fishing boats are kept getting bigger and bigger," says Charlie Howers, director of fisheries for the Fish and Wildlife Department.

Other regulations governing motor sizes and use of these lakes remain the same. Let's briefly run down what may be used where.

The following lakes permit no motors at all (including electric motors) — Chumley, Donnie Gooch, Martin County Lake and Kingston Cone Lake.

Only electric motors are allowed on Carver Creek Lake, Sportation Lake, Marion County Lake, Elliott County Sportsman's Lake, Lake Washburn, Bert Conroy Lake, McNeely Lake, Lake Mozy, Carpenter Lake, Kingfisher Lake, Malesico County Lake, Briggis Lake and all lakes on the Ballard Wildlife Management Area.

Motors larger than 10 horsepower may not be used on Greenlee Lake and the following lakes have a 10 horsepower maximum limit — Shanty Hollow, Bullock Pen, Bolts, Falmouth, Elmer, Shavers, Herb Smith, Corinth and Wilgreen.

On Guitt Creek and Bushbar, the sking season runs from the third Thursday in May through Sept. 30, while on Lake Malone, sking is permitted from the same opening day through Oct. 31.

Boats in all these state-owned lakes must slow down to 10 mph when they pass other boats in these lakes or are fishing, swimming in these lakes or are in a specified swimming area while a lifeguard is on duty.

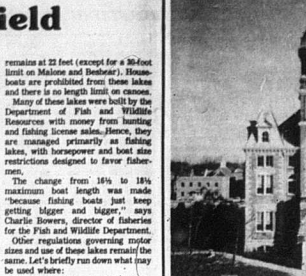
