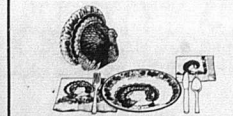

A 43-year-old native of Nicholas County died as an accidental shooting victim last Monday, Nov. 8, while hunting deer in Casey County.

The victim was identified as Vernon E. Bow, 43, who now lives in Route 1 in Daviess.

Casey County Coroner Bobby McKinney said Bow died to death as a result of a 30 caliber gunshot wound above his right knee.

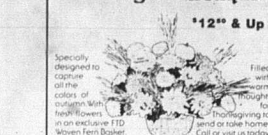
The coroner said that Bow's son was some distance away when the gun went off but that he did hear the gunshot.

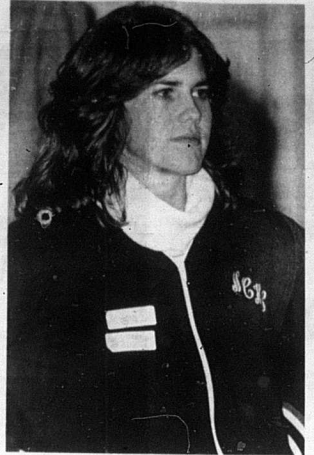
