Key's Kitchen

One more week of cookies than to something else. The ones this week need no baking. Some top of stove melting of chocolate or something but no oven cooking. These keep well so may be made anytime.

- MOCHA RUM BALLS
1/4 cup instant coffee
1/4 cup rum
1 tablespoon water
2 tablespoons cocoa
2 cups fine vanilla wafer crumbs
1 cup chopped walnuts
2 tablespoons light corn syrup
1 cup instant condensed sugar
Dash of salt
Dissolve coffee in rum and water in a bowl. Add remaining ingredients and mix thoroughly. Roll into balls, using rounded teaspoon of mixture for each. Store in tightly covered container for several days. Then roll in additional confectioners sugar. Makes about 4 dozen balls.

- PEANUT BUTTER BALLS
1/4 cup peanut butter
1/4 cup powdered milk
1 egg, slightly beaten
Wheat germ, optional
Cocoa, optional
Raisins, optional
Shredded nuts, optional
Combine peanut butter, powdered milk and honey. Mix together until smooth. If dough is too sticky, add more powdered milk, or if not sweet enough for your taste, powdered sugar. Pinch off dough in pieces and roll into balls.

- DATE NUT BALLS
18 ounces dates, pitted and chopped
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup butter, melted
1/2 cup raisins
1/2 cup chopped pecans, or more
Combine all ingredients except cereal; heat over medium heat until melted. Stir. Spread evenly over cereal. Melt chocolate in top of double boiler over simmering water. Spread over packing layer. Chill. Cut into bars of desired size.
