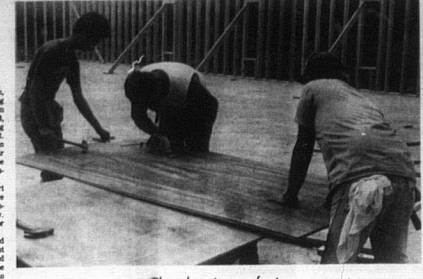
### Local cow greets Illinois man

### Fort Knox issues deer hunt regulations

Hunters who wish to pursue whitetail deer with a shotgun or muzzleloader at Fort Knox this fall can begin registering Aug. 16. All applications must be received by Aug. 31.

The military category hunter can sign up in person daily at Hunt Control, Building 633, French Range near the intersection of Upton and Main Range.

Office hours are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Non-military hunters must mail in their applications which cannot be post-marked earlier than Aug. 16 or later than Aug. 31.

The military hunter category covers all actively duty and retired military and their family members; reserve-component members; Fort Knox civilian employees and their family members; and civilian employees who have retired from the Kentucky post.

Persons who are not in any of the above mentioned groups are non-military hunters and must follow mail-in procedures.

Can hunt registration fees are \$10 for residents, and \$15 for non-residents. Non-military hunters must register by mail, paying their \$10 fee in the form of a postal money order, certified or cashier's check made payable to Finance and Accounting Officer, US Army, Fort Knox.

Send applications to the Merale Sport Activities, Hunt Control Office, Fort Knox, KY 40311.

All mail should contain a letter of recommendation from the local community. The purpose of this committee, which is composed of parents and teachers of children being served by federally funded programs, is to help design and implement these projects.

These programs in the Nicholas County School System include Chapters 1 and 11 of the Education Consolidation and Improvement Act of 1981 and Part B of the Education of All Handicapped Act.
