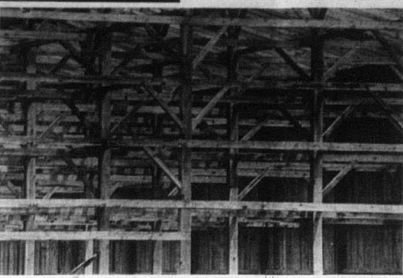

ASCS announces program changes

Lamb and wool producers will have an opportunity during Aug. 5-17 referendum to vote on whether they want the American Sheep Producers Council Inc. to conduct the market promotion and improvement program for their lamb by entering a new agreement with the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

The agreement to be voted on is similar to one approved in 1978, except it would authorize larger deduction from producer incentive payments to cover the cost of the program.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture has received applications for Community Credit Corporation farm storage facility loans, up to a total of \$40 million. The department has approved any new loans since Feb. 1 of this year.

One-half the estimated 1983 crop deficiency payments to the farm they sign up. This will help farmers who have tight cash flow programs.
