### Kay's Kitchen

February is the citrus month. Grapefruit, oranges, lemons, limes and tangerines are at their peak now. So it's time to use them in a variety of ways. Here are a few ideas:  
**GRAPEFRUIT SALAD**  
 1 3-ounce package lemon gelatin  
 1 cup boiling water  
 1 package plain gelatin  
 1 tablespoon cold water  
 1 cup grapefruit juice  
 1/2 teaspoon salt  
 1/2 teaspoon sugar  
 1/2 cup chopped orange  
 2 cups grapefruit sections  
 1/2 cup sliced almonds  
 Directions: Dissolve lemon gelatin in the boiling water. Add the plain gelatin which has been soaked in the cold water, the grapefruit juice, salt, sugar and gelatin. Let the mixture set until syrupy and add the grapefruit sections which may be cut in half. Add the almonds. Spoon into six-cup mold.  
 This salad is nice served with chicken. The onion flavor remains a mystery.

**COOKED ORANGES**  
 Wash and cut in half or tick slices three Navel oranges. Place in a saucepan and cover with boiling water, and cook for one hour. Drain well and discard water.  
 Cook 1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup water, and 3 tablespoons lemon juice for five minutes. Place the orange slices or halves in the syrup and cook them until tender, about one hour. Put in a jar and keep in a cold place until ready to use. The centers may be slightly hollowed and filled with cranberry preserves, or a tart jelly.  
 Note: To serve with herbs...  
**GRAPEFRUIT COMPOTE**  
 1/2 cup sliced grapefruit peel  
 Water  
 1/2 cup maple syrup  
 1 tablespoon grated orange rind  
 1 cup orange juice  
 1 cup grapefruit sections (about four large grapefruit)  
 Directions: Wash and peel the grapefruit. With sharp knife, score peel on one grapefruit into quarters, remove with fingers. With tip of spoon, scrape away all possible white membrane. Cut remaining peel into thinnest slivers to yield about 1/2 cup. Cover with water and boil about 10 minutes, until tender. Drain, drain and reserve.  
 In small saucepan, bring syrup, orange peel, and juice to a full boil. Pour hot mixture over grapefruit sections; marinate 30 minutes. Drain off all juice from sections into saucepan; add cooked grapefruit slivers. Boil, uncovered, stirring frequently.
