LEMON BILL INTRODUCED - Frankfort, Ky. - State Attorney General Sherman Beeson is endorsing a proposed new law which would help new car owners who have bought lemons. The bill was introduced by state Sen. David Karmali (D-Louisville). It passed by the 1962 General Assembly, the bill would require manufacturers selling in Kentucky to have a dispute resolution system in place Jan. 1, 1963.
