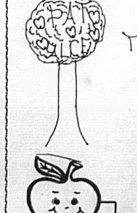
Dear Mrs. Fisher: Dear Mrs. Fisher: I have received three recipes that maybe you can use.

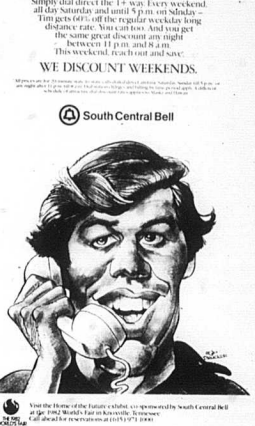
