

Unemployment drops again

Preliminary unemployment figures for April show that Nicholas County has had a percentage point drop in unemployment from 11.7 percent in March to 10.7 percent in April, according to figures released by the Department for Human Resources.

March unemployment was 10.2 percent, as the new figures reflect a drop in the number of unemployed persons. In Nicholas County, 1,082 says we have a work force of 200 persons, of which 200 are employed, leaving a total of 200 unemployed.
