An editor's random thoughts...

inspecting nearly every street-side maple for the old nests of woodpeckers or flickers. He doesn't hold his own, but will nest in nearly any hole or decayed limb crack he finds and the bird seemingly always thrives. If, in later nesting, a blackbird's nest were destroyed by the starling, no man's the worst for this gentle native bird.

Starlings were first introduced into this country by Eugene Schieffelin, who was also called by one of the first importations of English sparrows. Schieffelin released 40 starlings in Central Park, New York City, in 1860, and 40 more in 1891. Up until 1922 or later these birds were to be found no farther than 100 miles of New York. Then they began to come west in ever-increasing numbers. Ten years ago this spring I saw what I believe was the first nesting of starlings in Nicholas County in their dooryard on a wintry day will bring as many starlings as English sparrows. They flock in the fields of the county like blackbirds. Yet nearly every year someone tells me: "I saw a strange bird the other day. It was a sort of bobtailed blackbird with a white bill."

the survey was made on the basis of using one percent for the tax while retaining some of our present taxes, but the idea of a two percent tax and eliminating those mentioned above is under consideration.
