2 tablespoons brown sugar  
1/2 cup butter or margarine, melted  
1/2 cup brown sugar

10 Girl Scout Vanilla Sandwich Cookies  
1/2 dozen vanilla ice cream  
1 cup well-drained crushed pineapple  
1 cup chopped dates  
1 cup chopped nut meats  
1 cup heavy cream  
1 teaspoon lemon flavoring
