## Disability exemptions available on 1982 taxes

Those persons in the county who are 100 percent disabled may be eligible for a \$12,000 exemption on their assessed valuation. Rose Brady, Property Valuation Administrator, has just announced that persons who are 100 percent disabled according to the Social Security Administration, railroad retirement or the federal government, and own real estate in the county on which they live, should apply for the exemption.  
The disability exemption is a separate exemption from the Homestead exemption, Rose Brady said.  
This new exemption came into effect late last year without a lot of publicity, and some persons applied for it last year. Those persons must apply again, since the exemption is granted one year at a time.  
If you did not apply for this exemption last year, you should visit the Property Valuation Administrator's office upstairs in the courthouse in Carlisle. If you have any papers attesting to 100 percent disability from social security, railroad retirement or the federal government, you should bring those with you.
