The following are the facts concerning revenue from the sale of alcoholic beverages:

An Attorney General's opinion, based on KRS 139 and the case of George Wiedemann Brewing company vs. the City of Newport ruled that cities are confined to license fees as a source of revenue.

In a survey made a few years ago, it was found that approximately 1/10 of one percent of the city budget of Owensboro, Kentucky came from license fees for the sale of alcoholic beverages.

KRS 243, Section 17 states a regulatory license fee on the gross sales of alcoholic beverages may be levied but that tax may only be of sufficient percentage to cover the excess costs resulting from the sale of alcoholic beverages. The amount of license fees must be subtracted from the amount of taxes the city may levy. There can be no additional revenue from the sale of alcoholic beverages.

Concerned citizens should also be aware of the results of the latest Gallup Poll concerning the effects of alcohol on the American family. As reported in The Lexington Herald on November 16, 1982, this poll reported:

"That alcoholic abuse troubles one in three families in the United States and is considered a major national problem by more than 80 percent of the

"That forty-seven percent of those surveyed felt that heavy drinking can lead to the use of other drugs.

"That seventy-nine percent of those surveyed believed that alcoholism was a disease that should be treated in hospitals."

All citizens concerned with the future of our city and the people who live here should VOTE NO on December 4.
