Knowing what's going on during the 1982-83 marketing season is just a phone call away for Kentucky farmers, members of the news media and other individuals interested in the annual sales.
Information provided daily on the toll-free line will include the average price farmers are receiving for their tobacco at market locations, the number of pounds of tobacco sold, and grade and spot information.
The daily reports will be updated between 10 a.m. and 11 a.m. around 4 p.m. and again at 6:30 p.m. The 6:30 p.m. recording will be available on the line until the first update the following morning.
"We encourage everyone to make use of this special 24-hour service," Burley says. "Providing specific market prices and other marketing information should be of great assistance to the state's tobacco farmers."
