out his help. I'd still be three years back down the road from where I am now," he says. It takes time and money to use a computer.

In addition to the program Bill Jr. made, Gilmer has purchased several commercially programmed discs and has obtained several program discs through land grant colleges at nominal fees. More and more universities are writing computer programs for agriculture-related uses, Gilmer says.

He also pays for access to Compu-Serv, a data-base service similar to Operation Green Thumb, which provides information on weather, crops, market prices, other farm-related topics and national news. By simply dialing the phone, he can hook up his computer to receive up-to-the-minute information on any of these topics.

And while most of the time the computer is strictly business, Gilmer says there's nothing more relaxing than to come in from the fields and play a challenging game of chess with the computer. It's a tough opponent, he adds.

Gilmer foresees the computer as the up-and-coming tool for farming. That is a message he spreads among his farming friends and neighbors. Recently after seeing Gilmer's machine's capabilities, a neighboring farmer

bought a computer to figure his payroll and help get a handle on his labor expenses. What took his neighbor four hours each week to figure, now takes about two hours on the computer.

I feel like I'm on the leading edge of technology," Gilmer says. "In the near future, computer literacy is going to be as necessary as reading."

"The micro-computer can be compared to the hand-held calculator. At first they were expensive, now every one can afford one," he adds. "I think it's going to be the same with computers. As the prices go down, more and more people will have them and find the exciting results they can get."
