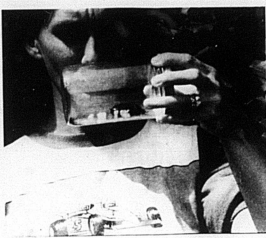

Cincinnati Art Museum acquires well-known Hogarth painting

The only major painting by William Hogarth to have remained in private hands until now has been acquired by the Cincinnati Art Museum. Director Richard F. Rogers Jr., announced today "Southwark Fair," signed and dated 1725, is an view with another new acquisition, the artist's engraving of the same scene, in the Museum's English galleries. The painting was purchased through the Edwin and Virginia Irwin Memorial Fund and the price was the gift of the Neumann and Brod company.

"Southwark Fair" is truly a masterpiece, the equal of other great English works in the Museum's collection," Rogers said. Famous for his satirical social comment and portrayals of London's seamy street life, Hogarth (1697-1764) was appointed to a silver engraver at the age of 21. The skill he acquired there enabled him to supplement his historical and narrative paintings with the marketing of engravings made from them. "Southwark Fair" was completed soon after his most famous series, "The Rake's Progress," and was offered for sale as an engraving along with "The Rake" in an advertisement of Dec. 22, 1724 in the London Journal. MSU and school districts announce joint program

Morehead State University President Morris L. Norfleet announced to Grayson Friday, Aug. 12, that MSU and at least 11 local school districts in Eastern Kentucky are launching a joint program to improve reading and mathematics skills of students currently at the elementary and middle school levels, including college.

"We are forming a new partnership in the quest for quality education and we are focusing our efforts on two of the most troublesome subject areas in our curricula," Dr. Norfleet said. More than 200 teachers at an inservice workshop sponsored by the Carter County Schools.

School districts already committed to the joint endeavor include Bath County, Carter County, Fairview, Fleming County, Greenup County, Lawrence County, Magoffin County, Montgomery County, Pike County, Rowan County and Russell County. Other districts also have expressed interest, he reported.

"We have pledged the university to do a better job of preparing new teachers in math and reading and to work with public school teachers and administrators through an expanded inservice program to help classroom teachers on all grade levels deal with the perplexing aspects of reading and mathematics education," Dr. Norfleet stated.

He added that MSU also will intensify its efforts to upgrade the math and reading capabilities of students currently enrolled. The first, external phase of the program will be conducted in sessions on the MSU campus for "instructional leaders" from the local districts. These leaders, in turn, will conduct similar sessions in their districts for classroom teachers.

"The university will utilize its own faculty and outside consultants to make sure that we have the best advice available," the MSU chief executive said. "We don't have all of the answers but we will work with our public school colleagues to find them."

Dr. Norfleet said the reading program would emphasize the concept of content-area reading instruction across the entire curriculum.
